**General Rules of the Creative Crafts
and Collections Department**

(See Competitive Entries General Rules & Regulations for further instruction.)

1. **Judging is closed to the public. Information on judging will not be available until after the Fair opens.**
2. Only residents of Arizona may exhibit in this department and must be non-professional, unless otherwise specified.
3. Exhibitors must derive less than 10% of their income from the sale of their articles.
4. No exhibit will be accepted unless there is a Division and Class listed in the Exhibitor's Handbook. Exhibitors are solely responsible for deciding on the proper Division and Class for their entry. Entries improperly classified will not be changed or judged.

5. Exhibitors must stay in their age groups. They cannot make entries in any other section except where stated otherwise. Please state age on entry form
6. All work must be the handiwork of the exhibitor and only articles completed within the past two years. An article may not be entered for competition more than two years. Articles deemed by judges as having been entered more than two years will be eliminated.
7. No article may be entered for more than one premium, and only one article may be entered in each class.
8. Schools & Groups should select and enter only their best exhibits.
9. Management and judges reserve the right to remove entries, which are considered obscene or harmful to minors, as defined in the Arizona Criminal Code.

Special Rules for Fashion Shows:

1. Entry into the Fashion Show is by invitation only and dependant on the number of entries received.
2. Fashion Shows is for any garment completely made by an exhibitor. This includes the divisions Made with Cotton, Other than Cotton, Crocheted or Knitted. Entry being shown must not be primarily comprised of store bought item(s).
3. To be eligible for the fashion show garment must have a 3"x5" index card attached with the Division, Class and Seamstress name at top. A description of the garment/article and model's name should also be included. All garments/articles must suitable for fashion show use.
4. For Made with Cotton and Other than Cotton garments/articles the lining and interfacing may contain blend. Garment may be trimmed in a non-cotton material i.e. belt, collar, cuffs or decorations.

SEWING SECTION

Special Rules for this Section of the Creative Crafts and Collections Department

1. Exhibits consisting of more than one piece must be securely fastened together.
2. Judging Criteria for Sewing and Crafts is based on general appearance, appropriateness, design, material, color, construction, creativity, technique, workmanship, stitches, and/or finishing (right and wrong sides).
3. Articles will not be judged or exhibited if they are stained, soiled or unsanitary.

COLLECTIONS SECTION

Special Rules this Section of the Creative Crafts and Collections Department:

1. **Due to the limited amount of display space, entries will be accepted on those who present the most educational value and uniqueness. Exhibitors will be notified by September 28 if their collection has been accepted for entry. All entry forms must be accompanied with a photo and a short description of the collection to be entered.**
2. Entries will be judged on the Danish system.
3. Display space will be pre-assigned. Collection displays shall have a maximum of 10 pieces for larger items and 20 pieces for smaller items; with the exception of mounted collections. Mounted collections shall not to exceed 720 square inches.

4. The Superintendent and/or Entry Director reserves the right to reject any collection if it exceeds the amount of display space assigned or is deemed unsafe for display.
5. Each displayed collection must be accompanied with a brief statement (on a 3" x 5" card only) how your collection was formed. How long did it take to build your collection? Was it gathered from many sources? Did you collect it personally? How many items are in your full collection? This information will be helpful to the judges and it will be of interest to the people who see your collection.
6. Collection shall be defined as a group of not less than ten (10) articles collected by the exhibitor. Articles in a collection must not be made by the exhibitor.
7. Collections entered as a club project cannot compete for cash awards in this department.
