SPECIAL RULES – READ CAREFULLY

IMPORTANT: Read carefully all GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS, YOUTH DIVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS and all HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1. THE **DEADLINE** for Youth Dairy entries is September 13. Entries will close sooner if capacity is reached. See General Rules Entry Requirements for additional explanation. Mail entries to Arizona State Fair, Livestock Entry Department, 1826 West McDowell Road, Phoenix, AZ 85007.
2. ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per head for each animal is required and must accompany official entry form. Please include a copy of the Dept. of Ag Seasonal pass along with your entry. **For online entries, mail or deliver the fees, copy of seasonal pass and signed entry form to the entries office within 5 days of deadline.**
3. Animals may be Registered or Grade. Separate classes will be shown for registered and Grade animals, except for Class 121 & Class 122. Grade animals will not be eligible to compete in the Open Dairy Cattle Show. **All exhibitors entering the Jersey Futurity Auction must enter either Division 189 or 289 and class 121 in addition to the correct breeding class (by age). No entry fee for Class 121 (Jersey Futurity).**
4. Must show registration papers or animal will be classified and shown grade. Grade animals must show major dairy breed characteristics and show in the class of major breed characteristic.
5. All stalls and pens, aisles, wash rack and milk parlor areas are to be kept clean at all times. If warned twice by Coordinator to clean any part of exhibitor's area, prize money may be forfeited. A stall sign displaying the exhibitor's name, animal's name and club, chapter or organization must be posted on animal's stall or pen.
6. Animals must be clipped at fair, excluding the head.
7. Exhibitor will NOT BE ALLOWED in the show ring without being in Show Dress (Show Whites) or Official FFA Dress.
8. First bedding will NOT be provided but will be available for purchase at the feed store, or you may bring your own.
9. Exhibitors must have a release from the feed and bedding provider before livestock release will be issued by department Coordinator. Coordinator will assign a time for release to prevent congestion entering the fairgrounds and around the barn areas. Vehicles will not be allowed to park behind the barn prior to release. All vehicles must be removed from the barn areas prior to 9:30 am daily.
