AWARDS: Awards will be given to the All--Around Champion and the winner of each event.

PERFORMANCES: Performances are scheduled:

- Friday, October 18 at 2:00pm and 7:00pm
- Saturday, October 19 at 2:00pm and 7:00pm

SLACK TIMES: Friday, Oct. 18, 2019 at 9:00am, and Saturday, Oct. 19, 2019 at 9:00am.

ADDED MONEY: The Arizona State Fair adds \$16,000.00 in total prize money. Added money is divided evenly among all events, with Team Roping receiving double the other events. (Header/Heeler even money)

- **Walk--in entries will only be accepted if mail--in entries do not fill the performances. Walk--in entries will be accepted on Monday, October 14 from 8:00am – 4:00pm at the Rodeo Office, located in the small barn office just north of the entrance gate at 19th Avenue and Monte Vista. Walk--ins MUST enter the grounds at this gate.**
If your mail in entry was not post marked/received by the deadline- you may present it as a "Walk-up" entry.
- **All payments must be in the form of cashier's check or money order. Cash and personal checks will not be accepted. Make money orders or cashiers checks payable to "Rodeo Secretary" Money orders or cashiers checks MUST contain contestant name and telephone number. Please state event entering on money order or cashiers check.**
- No telephone entries will be accepted.
- **- 1ST TO ENTER/LAST TO COMPETE- NO TRADES or SET-UPS will be honored.**
- Please be prepared to show identification to collect any checks from the Rodeo.
- **All Prize Money Winnings over \$600 will require a 1099 be filled out.**
- Contestant Rodeo Schedule will be placed online on the Honeycutt Rodeo Inc. Facebook page by Oct.15, 2019, and on the Arizona State Fair website (in the Entries section) by October 16, 2019.
- Callbacks will be October 16, 8:00am -12:00pm.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Native Americans with proof of tribal identification, NO EXCEPTIONS. All contestants in all events must be 18 or older. Contestants must present verification of age or tribal affiliation upon request by the Rodeo secretary. Contestants 21 and younger, please send a copy of proof of age along with entry.
