

2020 Youth Beef Cattle

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The Arizona State Fair is currently planning on holding youth livestock shows in a live, in person format. Should that change, a Virtual show will be offered to exhibitors.

\*PLEASE NOTE: IF LIVE SHOW GOES FORWARD, IT WILL BE A BLOW AND GO SHOW. NO FITTING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE FAIRGROUNDS.

\*\*IF LIVE SHOW GOES FORWARD – EVERYONE (EXHIBITORS, JUDGE, CLERKS, PARENTS, SIBLINGS, AND AUDIENCE) WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER FACE MASKS/COVERINGS.

\*A MINIMUM OF 10 EXHIBITORS (FOR THE BEEF DEPARTMENT) MUST ENTER. IF LESS THAN 10 EXHIBITORS, SHOW WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE A VIRTUAL SHOW.

SPECIAL RULES – READ CAREFULLY

IMPORTANT: Read carefully all GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS, YOUTH DIVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS and all HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- 1. THE DEADLINE for Youth Market Beef entries is September 1. The Deadline for Youth Breeding Heifers, Youth Feeder Beef and Youth Prospect Beef is September 25. Entries will close sooner if capacity is reached. See General Rules Entry Requirements for additional explanation.
2. Market beef entries must be entered online and include signature form, fees, a copy of the seasonal pass, and current copy of YQCA certificate (must be valid through fair). See Market Beef rules for details. Supporting documents must be uploaded within 5 days of online entry deadline. Supporting documents will not be accepted through the mail or in the office. Seasonal Pass must also be presented at time of arrival.
2a. Feeder and Prospect entries must be entered online and include signature form, fees, a copy of the seasonal pass, and current copy of YQCA certificate. Seasonal Pass must also be presented at time of arrival.
3. ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per head for each animal is required at time of online entry.
4. Stalls/Pens and wash racks must be kept clean at all times this includes aisles. If warned twice by Coordinator to clean any part of exhibitor's area, prize money may be forfeited. A stall sign displaying the exhibitor's name, animal's name and club, chapter or organization must be posted on animal's stall or pen.
5. THIS IS A BLOW AND GO SHOW! ANIMALS MUST COME TO THE FAIRGROUNDS "SHOW READY". Use of paint of any kind will not be permitted.
6. Exhibitor will not be allowed in the show ring without being in SHOW DRESS. See Jr. Livestock General Rules.
7. Bedding will not be provided.
8. There will be no parking behind the barns prior to release time. All vehicles must be removed from barn areas prior to 9:00 am every day.

PLEASE READ RULES CAREFULLY.

**FEEDER, PROSPECT & MARKET BEEF**

1. Feeder and Prospect animals are not eligible to transfer to the Market Beef Class.
2. All animals must be halter broken.
3. Animals shown as breeding animals are NOT eligible for these classes.
4. Junior animals will be classed by weights and divided into classes as determined by the Junior Beef Coordinator.
5. Underweight Prospect and Market animals will be transferred to the appropriate weight divisions. Overweight Prospect or Feeder animals may NOT transfer to the Market Beef Division.
6. At time of judging, market animals may be re-weighed. A weight variance exceeding 5% from the official weight is grounds for disqualification.
