

2020 Youth Dairy Goat
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The Arizona State Fair is currently planning on holding youth livestock shows in a live, in person format. Should that change, a Virtual show will be offered to exhibitors.

***PLEASE NOTE: IF LIVE SHOW GOES FORWARD, IT WILL BE A BLOW AND GO SHOW. NO FITTING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE FAIRGROUNDS.**

****IF LIVE SHOW GOES FORWARD – EVERYONE (EXHIBITORS, JUDGE, CLERKS, PARENTS, SIBLINGS, AND AUDIENCE) WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER FACE MASKS/COVERINGS.**

***A MINIMUM OF 10 EXHIBITORS (FOR THE DEPARTMENT) MUST ENTER. IF LESS THAN 10 EXHIBITORS, SHOW WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE A VIRTUAL SHOW.**

ENTRY DEADLINE Online: On or before 5:00 pm., September 25
ARRIVAL – NO EARLIER THAN Monday, October 19, 12:00 noon
ARRIVAL DEADLINE Tuesday, October 20 – 9am
Check in Tuesday, October 20, 10AM – 11am
JUDGING:
Showmanship..... Tuesday, October 20 12pm (noon)
Breed Shows..... Tuesday, October 20, following showmanship
Costume Parade Virtual
RELEASE..... Tuesday, October 20, after all shows have ended

SPECIAL RULES – READ CAREFULLY

IMPORTANT: Read carefully all **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS, YOUTH DIVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS** and all **HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

1. THE DEADLINE for Youth Dairy Goat entries is **September 25**. Entries will close sooner if capacity is reached. See General Rules Entry Requirements for additional explanation. Enter online or mail entries to Arizona State Fair, Livestock Entry Department, 1826 West McDowell Road, Phoenix, AZ 85007.
2. Entries must be completed online. ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per head for each animal is required and must be paid at time of online entry
- 2a. **For online entries, upload a copy of seasonal pass and signature form within 5 days of deadline.**
3. Animals must be clean and ready for the show ring at time of check-in.
4. First bedding will NOT be provided.
5. Muzzles made with mesh material may be used on an animal ONLY if the animal is bedded on shavings or straw, no synthetic materials (carpet) are used for bedding AND the exhibitor creates an educational poster about the proper use of Muzzles and displays the poster on the animal's pen. This is in addition to any posters entered as a Special Exhibit.
6. Stalls/Pens, wash racks and aisles must be kept clean at all times..

DAIRY GOAT SHOWS

1. Show Whites, or appropriate attire must be worn in the Show ring. (See Youth Livestock General Rules)
2. No Milk Out is required prior to the show.
