



The Arizona State Fair is currently planning on holding youth livestock shows in a live, in person format. Should that change, a Virtual show will be offered to exhibitors.

**\*PLEASE NOTE: IF LIVE SHOW GOES FORWARD, IT WILL BE A BLOW AND GO SHOW. NO FITTING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE FAIRGROUNDS.**

**\*\*IF LIVE SHOW GOES FORWARD – EVERYONE (EXHIBITORS, JUDGE, CLERKS, PARENTS, SIBLINGS, AND AUDIENCE) WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER FACE MASKS/COVERINGS.**

**\*A MINIMUM OF 10 EXHIBITORS (FOR THE DEPARTMENT) MUST ENTER. IF LESS THAN 10 EXHIBITORS, SHOW WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE A VIRTUAL SHOW.**

**SPECIAL RULES – READ CAREFULLY**

**IMPORTANT:** Read carefully all **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS, YOUTH DIVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS** and all **HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

1. **THE DEADLINE for Market Lamb entries is September 1. The Deadline for Breeding Sheep entries is September 14. The Deadline for Feeder Lamb entries is September 25.** Entries will close sooner if capacity is reached. See General Rules Entry Requirements for additional explanation. All entries are online only.
2. Entries must be completed online. ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per head for each animal is required.
- 2a. Complete market entries include signature form, fees, copy of Dept. of Ag. Seasonal Pass, and current copy of YQCA certificate (must be valid through fair). Supporting documents must be uploaded within 5 days of online entry deadline.
- 2b. All other entries include signature form, fees, copy of Dept of Ag. Seasonal Pass, and current copy of YQCA certificate (must be valid through fair). For breeding sheep, bring copy of registration papers to fair. Supporting documents must be uploaded within 5 days of online entry deadline.
- 2C. **BRING A COPY OF YOUR SEASONAL PASS WITH YOU TO THE EVENT!**
3. Sheep with any questionable health condition may be held before penning for inspection by the State Fair Veterinarian. Lambs may not show signs of sore mouth or fungal type lesions, such as Club Wool Fungus.
4. **NO DRENCHING** of any kind will be tolerated. Anyone found drenching (or any form of) will risk expulsion from the fair.
5. Flock tags or tattoo must be in animal's ear before judging.
6. First bedding will **NOT** be provided.
7. Muzzles made with mesh material may be used on an animal **ONLY** if the animal is bedded on shavings or straw, no synthetic materials (carpet) are used for bedding
8. It is expected that junior exhibitors will maintain their pen and surrounding area appropriate for a public and educational setting.
9. Sawdust/carpet/straw bedding is to be kept clean.
10. Aisles and grooming areas including wash racks must be kept clean and neat **AT ALL TIMES.**
11. In all Youth Sheep classes, the front feet of the sheep must remain on the show ring floor while being shown.

**REGISTERED BREEDING SHEEP DIVISIONS**

- 1. Exhibitors of sheep entered in Registered Breed Classes must present Breed Association / Registration papers at check-in.
- 2. Exhibitors of Commercial Ewes must present a Bill of Sale / Ownership papers at check-in.
- 3. All sheep of each division will be shown in their respective class. Class birthdates are as follows:

Computed Age ..... Date Born  
 2-year-old ..... September 2017 – August 2018  
 Yearling ..... September 2018 – August 2019  
 Fall Lamb ..... September 2019 – December 2019  
 Spring Lamb ..... January 2020 – July 2020 and must have lamb teeth

**FEEDER and MARKET LAMB DIVISIONS**

- 1. Exhibitors may enter a maximum of four (4) Market Lambs and a maximum of four (4) Feeder Lambs, and bring two (2) of each.
- 2. Lambs in these classes need not be registered.
- 3. Wether or ewe lambs are eligible.
- 4. **All lambs must have a scrapie id tag number at the time of entry. Scrapie tag number must be submitted online at time of entry.**
- 5. Lambs must have all lamb teeth.
- 6. Lambs will be classified for breed at weigh-in; decision of classifiers shall be final.
- 7. At weigh-in, lambs must be ready for the show ring, clean, slick shorn from the knee and hock up with wool length not to exceed 1/4".
- 8. Lambs will be weighed at the Fair and divided into 1 to 3 equitable weight classes in their respective breed divisions.
- 9. **Overweight Feeder Lambs may not transfer to the Market Lamb Division.**
- 10. **Lambs entered as Feeder or Market may not transfer to Commercial Ewes.**

**DIVISION NO. 203- FEEDER LAMBS**

- 1. No minimum weight. Southdowns & Cheviots over 90 lbs. & All Other Breeds over 100 lbs. cannot move to Market Division.

- 1. Entries must be completed online. Signature page, seasonal pass, and YQCA certificate must be uploaded within 5 days of the deadline.
- 2. The minimum weight for Southdowns and Cheviots is 90 pounds. The minimum weight for all other breeds is 100 pounds. Lambs not making weight may transfer to Feeder Lamb Division so long as the transfer does not exceed the two head entry limit.
- 3. At time of judging, market lambs may be re-weighed. A weight variance exceeding 5% from the official weight is grounds for disqualification.

**DIVISION NO. 208- PAIR OF MARKET LAMBS**

**PREMIUMS:** 1st 2nd 3rd  
\$20 \$15 \$10

- 1. Lamb pair weight classes will be determined after weigh-in. The heavier lamb of the pair will determine weight class.
- 2. There is NO ENTRY FEE for lamb pairs, but DIVISION 208 MUST be shown on the entry form.
- 3. Both lambs must be owned and entered by the same exhibitor.
- 4. Both lambs must have shown in their appropriate MARKET class.
