



**2021 Livestock Judging Contest
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 16, 8:30 AM**

ENTRIES

1. No entry form required. Registration to be completed at 8:30 AM on Saturday, October 16, 2021.

ELIGIBILITY

2. Club members in good standing are eligible for this contest.
3. Each Club or Chapter may enter multiple Junior and Senior teams in the Dairy Judging contest and multiple Junior and Senior teams in the Livestock Judging contest.
4. Past participants of the National 4-H or National FFA judging contest are not eligible to compete under that organization.

PASSES

5. All contest participants and their coaches who are participating in the Judging Contest will be admitted free of charge the morning of the contest between 7-9 am. This offer is good only at the WALK-IN gate at the 17th Avenue and McDowell Road entrance at the East end of the cattle barn. **Due to limited participant parking space, complimentary parking is NOT provided.**

DIVISIONS

6. The oldest member of the team will determine the classification for all members of that team for team and individual awards.
7. The Junior Division will consist of 4-H member under 14 years old on January 1st of the current year and FFA members that are currently a High School Freshmen.
8. The Senior Division will consist of 4-H members 14 to 18 years old on January 1 of the current year and FFA members that are currently a High School Sophomore, Junior or Senior.

TEAMS

9. Each team will consist of one to four members.
10. ADDITIONAL INDIVIDUALS will be allowed to judge as part of a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. Individuals are eligible for individual awards, but will not be included in team scores.
11. Team scores will consist of the combined scores of team members (excludes those designated as additional individuals) having the three (3) highest scores.

FORMAT

12. Contestants and their coaches are to assemble at the Ag Center Arena to register and receive instructions at 8:30 am. Contest will begin at 9:00 am.
13. Packets will be made up and coaches will name members competing the morning of the contest
14. There will be 10 minutes allowed for each class.
15. One set of oral reasons will be given on a designated class.

PROPER ATTIRE

16. FFA members should follow official dress code set forth by the FFA. 4-H does not have a dress code policy other than clothes should be neat and clean. Suitable clothes are sleeved shirts/blouses and long pants. NO TEE SHIRTS.

AWARDS

17. Buckles will be awarded to High Point Senior Livestock, High Point Senior Dairy, High Point Junior Livestock and High Point Junior Dairy. Awards will be presented at 2:00 pm in the Cattle Barn Show Ring.
