SPECIAL RULES – READ CAREFULLY

IMPORTANT: Read carefully all **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS, YOUTH DIVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS** and all **HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

1. THE DEADLINE for Youth Market Swine entries is **Aug. 6**. The Deadline for breeding gilts/prospect/feeder entries is **Sept. 14**. Entries will close sooner if capacity is reached. See General Rules Entry Requirements for additional explanation.
2. All entries must be completed online.
 - 2a. ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per head is required and must be paid online at time of entry.
 - 2b. **Market Barrow entries - This is a pedigree show.** Entries must include online entry, fees, signature form, copy of Dept. of Ag Seasonal Pass for each animal entered, and a current copy of YQCA certificate (must be valid through fair). **Pedigrees are required at check in.** Swine exhibitors may enter 4 market animals and bring two. Each exhibitor may sell only 1 market barrow auction, unless the exhibitor has both a Grand and Reserve Grand, in which case both must sell. Supporting documents must be uploaded within 5 days of online entry deadline. Supporting documents will not be accepted through the mail or in the office. **Seasonal Pass must also be presented at time of arrival.**
 - 2c. **Breeding Gilt/Prospect/Feeder entries** must include online entry, fees, signature form, and a current copy of YQCA certificate (must be valid through fair). Supporting documents must be uploaded within 5 days of online entry deadline. Supporting documents will not be accepted through the mail or in the office. **Seasonal Pass must also be presented at time of arrival.**
3. All market animals must have been farrowed on or after March 15, 2021 and must be in physical possession of and individually and continuously owned by the exhibitor by Aug. 6 of the current show year.

CHECK-IN

4. Exhibitor **MUST** provide their original Seasonal Pass upon arrival. Ear Notches on the certificate **MUST** match ear notches on animals.

WEIGH-IN/WEIGHT LIMITS

5. The Minimum weight for market swine is 230 pounds and the maximum weight is 285 pounds. Underweight swine may be moved to prospect/feeder class (swine entered in prospect or feeder class can NOT be moved up to market). Prospect swine weight is 185-229 lbs. Feeder swine are less than 185 lbs. Swine less than 15 pounds over the maximum weight will be allowed to show but must weigh within 15 pounds of 285 pounds at weigh-back. Swine more than 15 pounds over the maximum weight will not be eligible to show. Excessive shrinkage **WILL NOT** be tolerated. Any abuse will be grounds for disqualification.
6. Exhibitors must turn in the official show/sale weight for each animal **by 9:00am** the day prior to the Market Swine Show. This weight is the official weight and will be used for classing and selling. Weight changes will not be allowed at any time.
 - 6a. Feeder, Prospects, and Gilts weigh in Wednesday after sheep and goats – approx. 4:30pm.

7. Immediately before, or after time of judging, animals may be weighed at the discretion of the Coordinator. If there is a weight variance of 15 pounds or more from official weight turned in by the exhibitor, the animal will be disqualified. Weight turned in by the exhibitor will remain the official weight for sale animals.

BEDDING & PENS

8. First bedding will NOT be provided but will be available for purchase at the feed store, or you may bring your own.
9. Exhibitors must have a release from the feed and bedding provider before livestock release will be issued by the department Coordinator. Coordinator will assign a time for release to prevent congestion entering the fairgrounds and around the barn areas. Vehicles will not be allowed line up prior to release times. All vehicles must be removed from the barn areas prior to 9:30 am daily.
10. Pens must be kept clean before and after the judging has been completed. A stall sign displaying the exhibitor's name, animal's name and club, chapter or organization must be posted on animal's stall or pen.
11. No automatic waterers or hoses will be allowed in the pens
12. Exhibitors will not be allowed to wet down bedding.

CLASSIFICATION

13. Swine will be classified for breed at check-in. The decision of the classifier is final.
14. If there are less than three exhibitors in a breed class, they may be transferred to the All Other Breeds Division.

CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES FOR PUREBRED BARROWS

- Berkshire:
 1. A black and white animal with erect ears exhibiting Berkshire character.
 2. A Berkshire must have white on all four legs, face and tail (unless tail is docked). One of the white leg points may also be missing.
 3. Must be ear notched within seven days of birth.
 4. A Berkshire must NOT have a solid white or a solid black face from the ears forward.
 5. A Berkshire must NOT have a solid black nose (rim of nose).
 6. White is allowed on the ears, but NO solid white may appear on the ears.
 7. Occasional splash of white may appear on the body.
- Chester White:
 1. Must possess Chester White Breed Character.
 2. Must be ear notched within seven days of birth.
 3. Must be solid white in color, no color on the skin larger than a silver dollar, no colored hair.
 4. Ears must be down and medium size.
 5. Any signs of weighted ear tags or evidence of past existence of such ear tags are determined to be not permissible and are grounds for disqualification.
- Duroc:
 1. Must be red in color and possess Duroc Breed Character. (Ears must be down and medium size)
 2. Must be ear notched within seven days of birth.
 3. Must NOT have any white hair located on the animal.
 4. Must NOT have any black hair.
 5. Must NOT have more than three black spots on the skin and none of these spots can be larger than two inches in diameter.
 6. Must NOT have any shading or indication of a belt.
- Hampshire:
 1. Must be black in color with a white belt starting on the front leg. The belt may partially or totally encircle the body.
 2. Must possess Hampshire Breed character. (Ears must be erect and not rounded)
 3. Must be ear notched within seven days of birth.
 4. Must NOT have any white hair or indications of streaking on the forehead.
 5. Must NOT have any red hair.
- Landrace:
 1. Must be white in color and possess Landrace Breed character. (Ears must be down)
 2. Must be ear notched within seven days of birth.
 3. Must NOT allow any color hair other than white.
 4. Must NOT allow more than three spots of skin pigmentation.
 5. Must NOT allow any spot of skin pigmentation larger than one U.S. minted quarter.
- Poland China:
 1. Must possess Poland China Breed character.
 2. Must be ear notched within seven days of birth.

3. Must be black with six white points (face, feet and tail) with an occasional splash of white on the body. A hog may not possess more than one black leg and be determined as a Poland China. (Tail docking is permissible eliminating that white point.)
4. Must have ears down.
5. Must NOT have evidence of belt formation.
6. Cannot have any red or sandy hair and/or pigment.
7. Hogs that have weighted ear tags or evidence of tampering with possible ear tags are ineligible.

- Spotted:

1. Must be black and white in color.
2. Must possess Spotted Breed character.
3. Must be ear notched within seven days of birth.
4. Ears must not be erect.
5. Any red tinted or sandy brown spots are ineligible.
6. No solid black head from ears forward.
7. No distinct white belt pattern (hair or skin) encircling and extending down and onto each shoulder.

- Yorkshire:

1. Must be white in color and possess Yorkshire Breed character. (Ears must be erect)
2. Must be ear notched within seven days of birth.
3. Must NOT have any colored hair other than white.
4. Must NOT have colored skin pigmentation larger than one U.S. minted silver dollar.
5. Must NOT have masking above the eyes larger than a silver dollar.

SHOW RING

15. Exhibitors must be in proper dress to enter the show ring – see General Youth Division Rules. If not in appropriate dress, exhibitor will not be allowed in the ring.

BREEDING GILT/PROSPECT/FEEDER DIVISIONS

They may not be bred or have farrowed a litter to be considered for the gilt show. Gilts will be shown by weight and breed. Crossbred Gilts will be shown by weight. The maximum weight for Crossbred Gilts is 375.

When entering Gilts, Prospects and/or Feeders, provide the number of head you will be entering. Bring your Seasonal Pass showing the entered pig(s) to check-in.
