



Stage Lead

Job Summary:

The Arizona Exposition and State Fair seeks a Stage Lead to play a role overseeing our community stage performers the day of their performance including regular communication and logistical support to our performers, Community Stage Coordinator, and Events and Entertainment team. This is a temporary, part-time position during the 2022 Arizona State Fair. This fun and unique position within the Events Department requires strong communication and independent judgment skills.

Duties Include:

- Communicating performance needs to audio engineers.
- Assisting performers load in and load out by use of golf cart as needed.
- Ensuring the daily performers adhere to the schedule.
- Uses reasoning to manage adjustments in the performance schedule.
- Maintaining regular communication with community stage coordinator.
- Documenting performance issues and/or concerns.
- Ensuring the stage act adheres to the Community Stage Handbook.
- Serve as a resource for the performer by representing the Arizona State Fair and its facilities.

NOTE: Flexible weekend and evening schedules are required during the 2022 State Fair (Sep 23 -Oct 30, Thursdays -Sundays). Applicants should have access to reliable transportation. Applicants must pass an employment background.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, & ABILITIES The ideal candidate must exhibit a strong work ethic, be detail-oriented, display a professional demeanor, and have the ability to multi-task when needed. Customer service and communication skills are required for this position.

Requirements:

- Ability to prioritize multiple projects and change priorities quickly.
- Ability to communicate effectively with Fair crew and community performers.
- Ability to work with a diverse population.
- Ability to identify and resolve problems with performers
- Basic knowledge of equipment commonly found on a stage. (e.g., lighting, sound, and stage areas, etc.)
