COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL

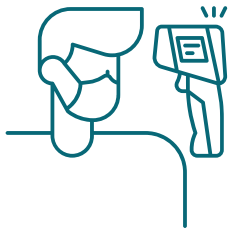
To ensure that you and our staff are protected, all attendees must do the following:

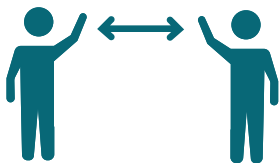
COVID-19 ATTESTATION FORM - All attendees must sign a Covid-19 attestation form indicating that they do not currently have Covid-19 and have not been directly exposed to someone who is positive within the last 48 hours



TEMPERATURE CHECKS - Upon registration, all attendees are required to have their temperature checked. A temperature over 99 is not permitted.



SANITIZING & HAND WASHING - Sanitation stations will be provided throughout the event. Please wash your hands with warm soap and water after eating, coughing, sneezing, etc.
